

# 教育部 106-107 Teep@India 南華大學結案報告

## 一、摘要

感謝教育部這項提供印度優秀青年在台灣蹲點的試辦計畫，感謝高教司吳亞君研究員給予行政支援及一年來協助全國各大專院校主持人完成此項任務。讓所有 Teep 之印度學員並以手續簡便，方便學員入台簽證等都相當便利。本校獲得 357,400 元，支援七位 Teep @India 學生，每名學生每月 1 萬元新台幣獎助學金，獎助學金共計 280,000 元。其餘，作為文化之旅與華語密集或其餘雜支等，共計 77,400 元。每位學員由本校頒授結業證明乙紙，舉行成果分享，學員對台灣印象極佳。七名學員之一，Monika Kumari 決定直接申請成為本校 107 學年度企管系碩士班學生，並獲得獎學金。

I am grateful to the Ministry of Education for providing a Teep@India project for the outstanding young Indians in Taiwan. I would like to thank the researcher Jennie Y. Wu, Ph.D. Researcher

Department of International and Cross-strait Education of the Higher Education Department for giving administrative support and a year to assist the host of the colleges and universities across the country to complete this task. It is quite convenient for all Teep@Indian students to have simple procedures and facilitate the entry of visas for students. The Nanhua University, has received 357,400 NTD and supports seven Teep @India students. Each student has a monthly NT\$10,000 scholarship and a scholarship of 280,000 NTD. The rest, as a cultural trip and Chinese-speaking or other miscellaneous matters, totaled 77,400 NTD. Each student was awarded a certificate of completion by the Nanhua University and shared results. The students were very impressed with Taiwan Experience. One of the seven students, Monika Kumari, decided to apply directly to become a master's degree student in the 107th School of Business Administration of the school and receive a scholarship.

## 五、學員心得報告

@ VIKRANT JAISWAL 維侃



How the miracle of our meeting  
Shone there and sang,  
I didn't want to return  
From there to anywhere.  
Happiness instead of duty  
Was bitter delight to me.  
Not obliged to speak to anyone,  
I spoke for a long while.  
Let passions stifle lovers,  
Demanding answers,  
We, my dear, are only souls  
At the limits of the world.

This could be a short description of how elated I felt when I met Chueming Shi. I had neared my M.Phil and she offered me the scholarship of Teep@ India on the recommendation of my Head of Department in University of Delhi, Prof. Anita Sharma.

The news didn't become a wildfire but kept tight-lipped between my family friends and myself. Going abroad for further studies had always been my dream. Very few people I interacted, knew about Taiwan. Ofcourse, it wasn't a big country like Canada or The United States but a small island country. Some, even thought it to be Thailand or Taliban areas.. Well, it had been a herculean task to make them understand that Taiwan, officially the Republic of China (ROC), is a state in East Asia. Its neighbors include the People's Republic of China (PRC) to the west, Japan to the northeast, and the Philippines to the south. It is the most populous state and largest economy that is not a member of the United Nations. .. Finally after completing my visa formalities and other necessary work I bid my dear ones goodbye for six long months. I remember stuffing my bags with exotic Indian spices as I was sure the delicacies of my tongue would be getting a break. After a long flight I landed at Taipei airport. I felt I've crossed some kind of invisible line. I felt as if I've come to a place I never thought I'd come to. And I don't know how I got here. It's a strange place. It's a place where a little harmless dreaming and then some sleepy, early-morning talk would eventually lead me into considerations of death and annihilation. Taipei was beautiful, I stood there and started wondering my life would have been incomplete without visiting this place.

I love people who makes me happy all  
the time



Somehow I had passed the boundaries of language and found clarity in shared thoughts even if I was just talking about beer...

The Nanhua University had sent Khemraj , to pick us up from the airport , and we moved comfortably to the dormitory where my next six months would be soujourned.

Food was an essential problem as I didn't eat pork and beef neither I liked the essence of it . It was way away from that of the exotic spices of my land. I recollect buying pastries and dumping them as it had less sugar. The vegetables were too not like India.

So I took up cooking with my fellow mates with the spices I had got from home , and slowly Infact very slowly I got acquainted with the local cuisine ... And wao ! I discovered dishes which had similar tastes like that of India. The first two months though Mac Donald's and Subway aided me... Here , unlike India , classes continue from 7am until 10pm . The weather was something I wasn't accustomed with ... It brought in chilly winds to torrential rains to bright sunny times too... I was always unprepared ... So one day it happened I got drenched by the untimely rain ... Seeing this Anita laoshi , who taught me ( , and 2 other teep students Basic Chinese, in the initial days.) gifted an umbrella and a hair dryer to keep us protected and dry.

Here people taught me to be humble and that the emphasis and the reason for a pure humility is to result in love for others; not always necessarily the belittlement of self.

In a while , the school had given a break for winter break so we were advised to moved to Fo guan Shan monastery . It was difficult as I was never used the monastic life ... I came back along with another teep student back to Nanhua after a week of staying. On coming back , as the silence returned because the dormitory was deserted mostly , because all had gone home for break, I sat back and felt tension easy away . I hadn't even known I was tensed or ill at ease. I cycle a lot on empty days and that particular day I did so , the cycle paddle laced in with the clanging chains and eventually got mixed with the rumbling of cars and buzzing insects of Dalin.

My co - mate and I resumed to cooking and within a blink the holidays got over and so was my leisure.

Nanhua University, as given me my childhood ... Like I joined karate which I started again after 10 long years . Dance was one of my childhood passions which I am learning now (hip-hop) . I joined management classes and yoga apart from Chinese.

I believe cities or countries were always like people, showing their varying personalities to the traveler. Depending on the city or county and on the traveler, there might begin a mutual love, or dislike, friendship, or enmity. Where one city will rise a certain individual to glory, it will destroy another who is not suited to its personality. Only through travel can we know where we belong or not, where we are loved and where we are rejected.

Taiwan has always made me feel belonged .  
I visited the jaw dropping Alishan mountains and to the beautiful Sun Moon Lake ... To amazing cities which it has produced to name a few .  
I am so much in love that I would like to uphold Nanhua university and Taiwan to Indians and if given a chance I want to return with higher aims .... Indeed Taiwan is the heart of Asia.

Within the blink of an eye the time passed, and I had to leave and since then I miss Taiwan so much and if there's any other short term programme I would love to visit Taiwan again.

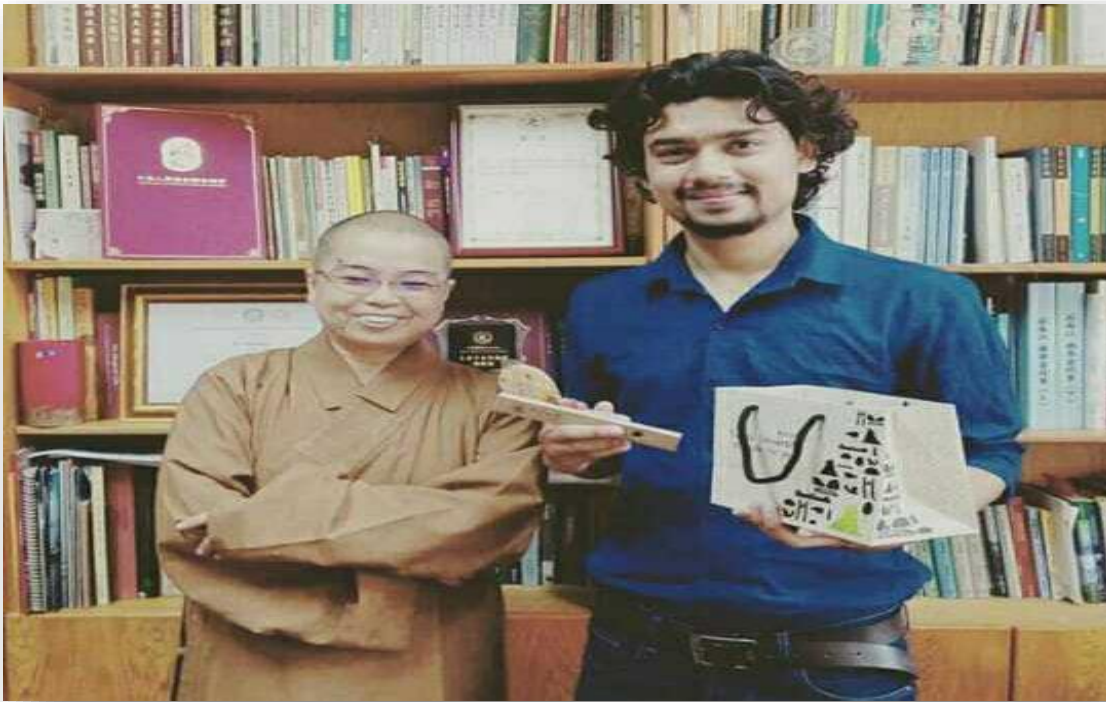

As I arrived to Taiwan Taoyuan airport Mr. Vikrant Jaiswal who was also a teep@india student came to pick me & asked me did you eat anything so I said no I didn't, because as I arrived to airport I was confused what to eat & what not so I decided it's better to eat when Vikrant will come after that first time I experienced the life of Taipei it was so busy, everyone was so busy some were engaged in their work some of them were heading towards their destination place as I was going to my residential place at evening I arrived to Nanhua dormitory where I was going to spend three & half months. As I arrived first I met to Monika who was also a teep@india student and after met to aayi (like mother) who handed over me a key of mine room so on that particular moment I started talking in Chinese with aayi then Golu came and he said that he is mine roommate as I heard I was glad because I wasn't sure with whom I will live in dormitory. I met teacher but unfortunately that day there was a test so teacher said me if you want you can also give test but I thought i didn't attend any class how can I be able to write but as I saw paper I knew many things about it I thought oh my god how easy it is I was just simply worrying then after as I submitted an answer sheet to laoshi she said how you done this correctly I said actually I have already studied Chinese but had no atmosphere to speak now I got it so I was talking to laoshi in Chinese and I asked many things and was glad to answer because she didn't expect it .
